Daniel is an American serial entrepreneur, author, and keynote speaker. He is best known for his bestselling books *No Stone Left Unturned*, *Retirement Simplified*, and *Pay Off Your Mortgage*.

He is regarded for his clear-cut style of writing and storytelling that focuses straight on the core concepts of financial strategies on tax reduction and retirement security.

My intent with Old School is to tell our stories and how we walked them. What we did to get and maintain health in the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual areas of our lives. So I want to hear a bit of your story, but my real interest for both myself and my listeners, is how you help old ladies retire well.

So what is your process? Say I come in to sit down with you and make a plan. I am divorced, I am old and I didn't come out of my divorce with any retirement. My only real debt is my home. Am I hopeless?

Daniel: My mission is to help people discover what they are "retiring to". Retirement means literally, "being taken out of service". Well I like the idea of people retiring to a purpose and aligning that with whatever income stream can bring more satisfaction to your "retirement" years than any pile of money. It can also become a revenue stream in and of itself.

Daniel's Nugget:

"We think 60-80k thoughts per day. They will continue to be very similar to the day before if we don't become conscious about what our subconscious is telling us. If we feed into those thoughts

intentionality and a choice toward the positive, then we will see the goals of health in all areas of our life.”
